DELICIOUS THAI DISHES

Thailand is known for their delicious food and wide variety and mixture of savory to sweet foods. It is sure to be one of the most popular types of cuisines across the world. Traditional Thai food is known to be full of flavor and famous for being spicy yet extremely tasty. Here are five of some of the most popular meals and desserts to try when in Thailand or visiting on holiday, that can easily be found on side streets, markets and restaurants and are usually highly affordable.

Somtam: A very popular dish that originates from the North East parts of Thailand is also known as Papaya salad. This dish can be prepared in a variety of ways and is usually made spicy and served with sticky rice. Somtam uses a unique ingredient and the most popular way of being made is by adding crab and fermented fish sauce.

Boat Noodles: Thai style noodle dish that is strong in flavor. It contains both pork and beef, as well as dark soy sauce, pickled bean curd, and some other spices. It is normally served with your choice of noodle and meatballs and pig's liver.

Khanom Khrok: A sweet coconut milk desert with a variety of toppings such as sweet corn. Khanom Khrok is also known as a coconut-rice pancakes and is a traditional Thai dessert. It is prepared by mixing rice flour, sugar, and coconut milk to form a dough. Khanom Khrok is composed of two batters, one salty and one sweet, both of which are cooked in a heating mantle-a hot indented frying pan and can be found at many night markets and street food stalls for an inexpensive price.

Krapow: This has to be by far one of the most popular dishes for Thai people to order and a very common dish to be served in restaurants and stalls as is usually always to be found on the menu. This dish is a stir fry basil and chili dish that is served with a variety of choice of meats but is most popular with minced pork and served paired with a fried egg.

Salim: Sweet Noodles in sweet Coconut Milk is a traditional Thai dessert of multi-colored mung bean flour noodles or threads, topped with sweetened flavored coconut milk and served over crushed ice. It is popular across Thailand and can be found at many local markets sold with other traditionally Thai desserts or traditional Thai restaurants.



The government has decided to temporarily suspend the entry of both Thais and foreign arrivals under the "Test & Go" scheme and restore mandatory quarantine in a bid to keep the Omicron coronavirus variant at bay.

Prime Minister Prayut Chan-o-cha said the government would stop approving new applications for Test & Go entries except to the Phuket Sandbox until 4 January.
